## ADDENDUM 1 Dated: May 27, 2021

The following questions have been submitted for clarification:

- 1. There appears to be 12,000 LF of saw cutting for the project. Would you consider adding a saw cut line item or should this just be included in the asphalt demo line item?

  Answer: The saw cutting is included in the asphalt removal pay item (2025000).
- 2. Just confirming the only in contract utility work is the new water line between Wichman and Ireland Creek? All other water/wastewater conflicts will be relocated by the City? Answer: Correct, the City will handle the relocation of the other conflicts as noted.
- 3. Clarify the location of "Moving Item No.1". Answer: This is for the relocation of the church sign on tract 157 at Sta. 167+20 Rt.
- 4. Can any additional information be provided on the underdrain such as proposed elevations? The standard detail just states the rock must be 4" above and a minimum of

- 20", but there's not enough information to know the proposed depth and width. Answer: The underdrain should comply with SCDOT Standard Drawing 802-205-00. The size of the underdrain is 6-inches and the depth is minimum of 2-feet. The contractor can field adjust the underdrain in order to maintain positive drainage.
- 5. Within the specs there is a confliction for mulches pertaining to trees and shrubs. Also, within the plant section there is only an indication of trees and shrubs but not to ground coverings or flower beds. What type of mulching would go there? Answer: Pine needle mulch is to be used in all areas of the project.
- 6. Are daytime lane closures allowed? Answer: Yes
- 7. Can the contract be extended beyond the stated 180 days? Answer: Yes, the contract completion date is hereby changed to 240 days from NTP. Also by this addendum, substantial completion does not include mast arm installation.
- 8. Is there an NTP date or completion date the City would like to maintain? Answer: No, the City will work with the reasonableness of the Contractor's schedule.
- 9. Sheet 21 Relocate Sign: This sign is built out of masonry construction. Is this sign to be re-built the same as it is now? Answer: Yes
- 10. Up lighting for the gateway sign where is the power source located for the up lights?

  Answer: The contractor is to provide power to the lights. An existing electric meter and power source is located in the landscape island and is within 40' from the gateway sign.
- 11. There are 4 wayfinding signs shown on plan page SN00-1, the bid form has a quantity of 3? Answer: The bid form has been updated to 4. See attached revised bid form.
- 12. The brick for the main gateway sign are no longer available (Borel 17<sup>th</sup> Century Collection) can you spec a brick that is available? Answer: Replace the Borel 17<sup>th</sup> Century "Orleans" brick with Old Carolina "Georgetowne".
- 13. What permits will be required by the contractor? Answer: None. All permits have been obtained by the City.
- 14. On page 5-F is the 8" white crosswalk line part of the texturing system or thermos striping? Answer: The 8" line is thermoplastic pay item 6271015 and separate from the texturing pay item 4039000.
- 15. The specs state the contractor will be responsible to quality control and quality assurance testing, will the contractor be responsible for paying for this testing? Answer: Yes, the contractor will be responsible for ensuring all materials meet the specifications and are installed correctly. The City will also provide construction observation services.
- 16. Can the City provide a digital copy of the formatted bid form in Microsoft Excel?

  Answer: Yes, please email <a href="mailto:charvey@colletoncounty.org">charvey@colletoncounty.org</a> to request a copy. All bids must be submitted on the form provided in the bid solicitation.

- 17. Will the mast arm and pedestal pole design need to match those that were installed on the I-95 Loop Project Streetscapes Phase 1B? If so will a line item be added for Luminaire Assemblies? Answer: Yes, the design will be the same including the luminaire. A separate line item will not be provided for the luminaire.
- 18. Per the mast arm location on the east side of Sweat St & N Jefferies Blvd, has any additional consideration been given to the lack of space between Ireland Creek & Sweat St? Answer: The proposed pole location was reviewed and approved by SCDOT during design coordination.
